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## HIV Infection in Alaska, 2005

A cumulative total of 1,050 cases of HIV infection were reported to the Alaska Section of Epidemiology through December 31, 2005. Of the 1,050:


- 727 (69%) were reported with AIDS and 323 (31%) were reported with HIV infection without AIDS;
- 847 (81%) were male; and
- 341 (32%) are known to have died.

Additional data will be published in the *Epidemiology Recommendations and Reports* in mid-2006.




**Cumulative Number of HIV Cases and Known Deaths by Year of First Known HIV Diagnosis through December 31, 2005**
